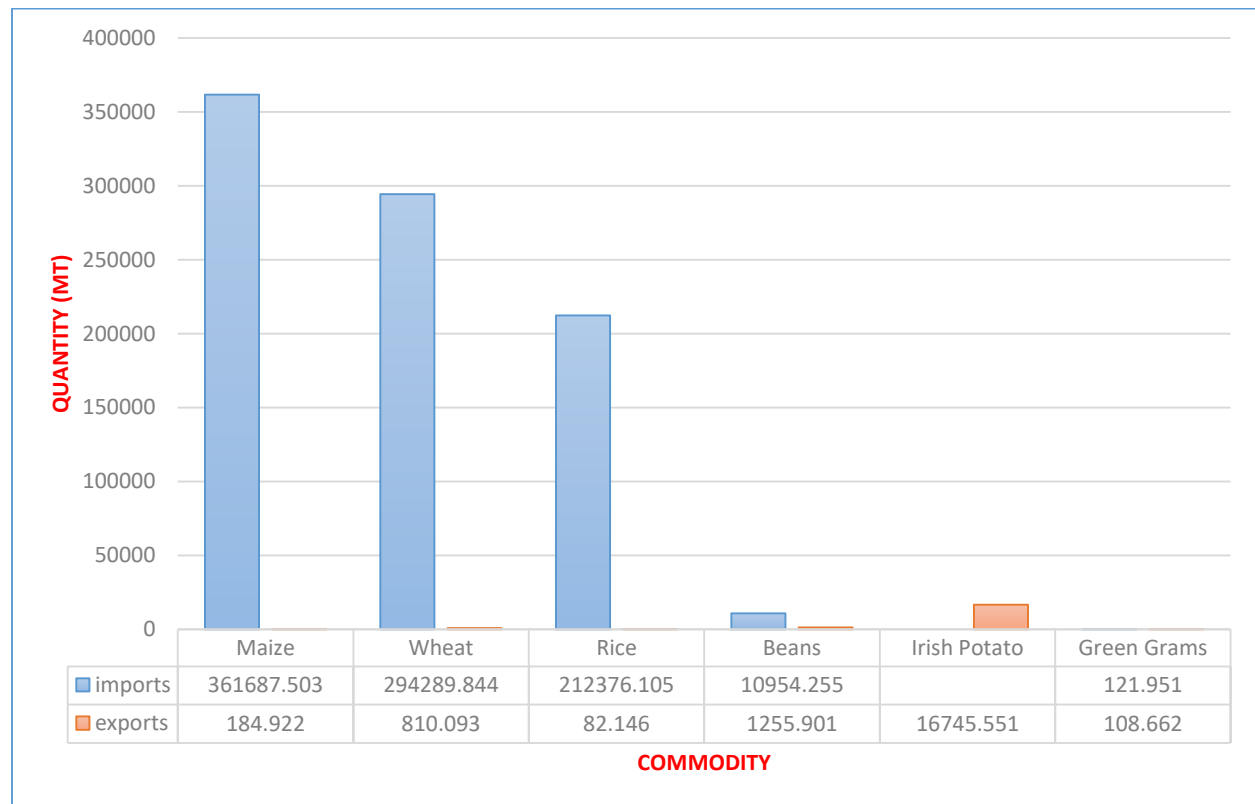


Import and Export of Key Food Crops Commodities (Quarter 1, July to September - 2022/2023)

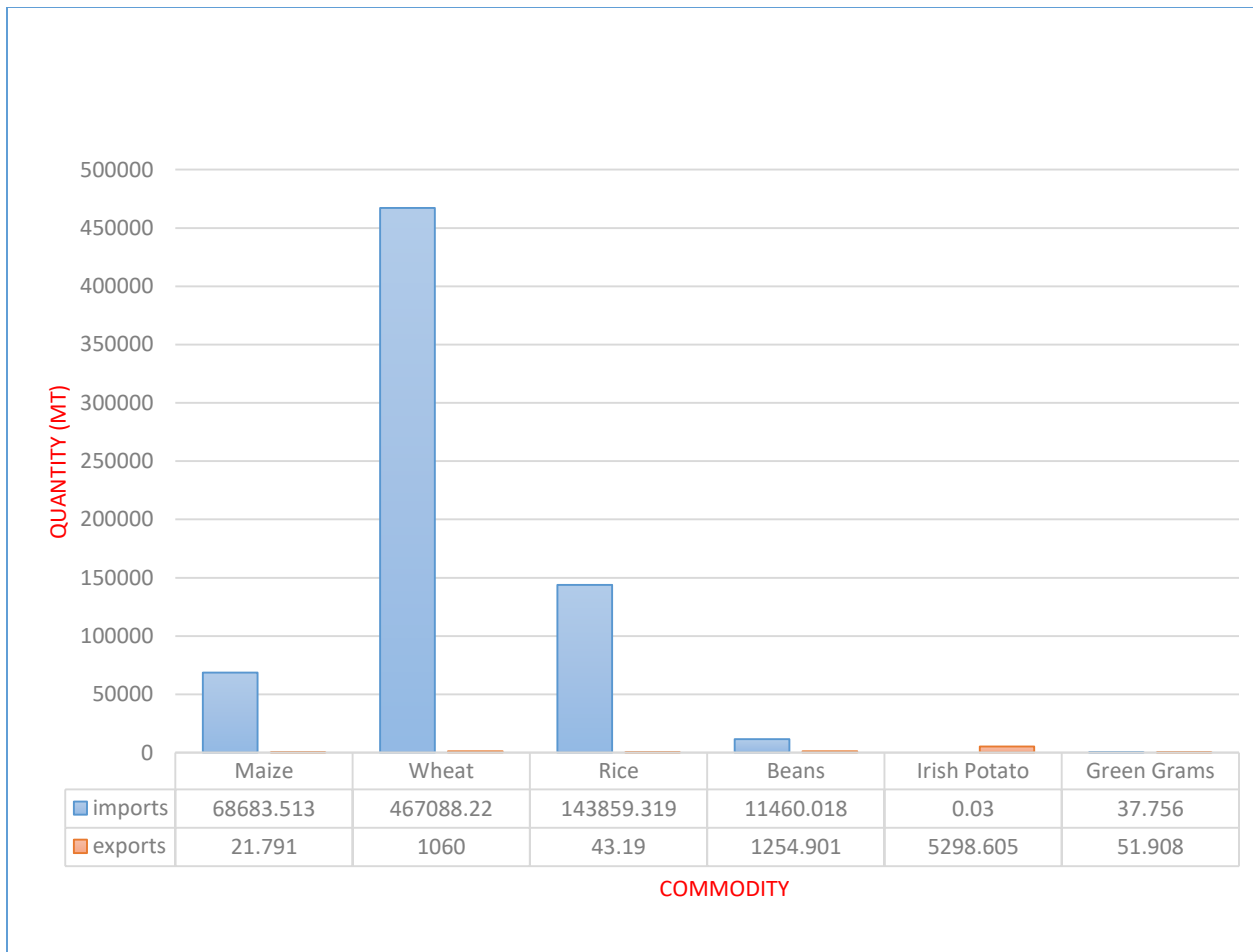


Comments: Maize, Wheat and Rice respectively were the major import commodities followed by Beans while there were no imports of Irish potato and an insignificant quantity of Green Grams imported during the quarter.

Irish potatoes was the major export commodity followed by Beans, Wheat, Maize, Green Grams and Rice during the quarter.

Main import sources for Maize, Wheat, Rice, Beans and Green Grams were Tanzania, Russia, India, Ethiopia and Uganda respectively. While the main exports destinations for Irish Potatoes, Beans, Wheat, maize, Green Grams, and Rice were Uganda, India, Uganda, Tanzania, Vietnam and DRC respectively.

Import and Export of Key Food Crops Commodities (Quarter 2, September to December - 2022/2023)



Comments: Wheat, Rice, Maize and Beans continued to dominate imports while Irish potatoes and green Grams imported during the quarter were very low. Wheat imports increased above first quarter quantities while maize and Rice imports declined significantly.

Irish potatoes and beans remained the main export commodities followed by Wheat while Green Grams, Rice and Maize were also exported though the quantities were insignificant.

The main import sources for Wheat, Rice, Maize and Beans were Australia, India, Tanzania and Ethiopia respectively while the main exports destinations for Irish Potatoes and Beans were Uganda and South Sudan respectively.
